Magento 2 Module — Complete User Guide

Complete Guide — Every Screen, Every Button, Step by Step

Rebuild Magento indexers directly from the admin panel with a one-click Reindex All button and a mass-reindex action on the Index Management grid — no SSH or command line required. Works on Magento Open Source and Adobe Commerce, Hyvä compatible, and ACL-controlled.

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1. Introduction

Admin Reindex adds reindex controls directly to Magento's built-in Index Management screen. It lets administrators rebuild indexers from the browser — a one-click Reindex All button plus a mass-reindex action for selected indexers — with no command line or SSH access needed.

The module is licensed through the eTechFlow portal. Until a valid key is entered for your domain, the module's controls stay locked. This guide covers using the module from Magento's Index Management screen.

2. Using Admin Reindex

Once activated, the module's controls appear on Magento's standard Index Management screen. Open it from System → Index Management (or Tools → Index Management).

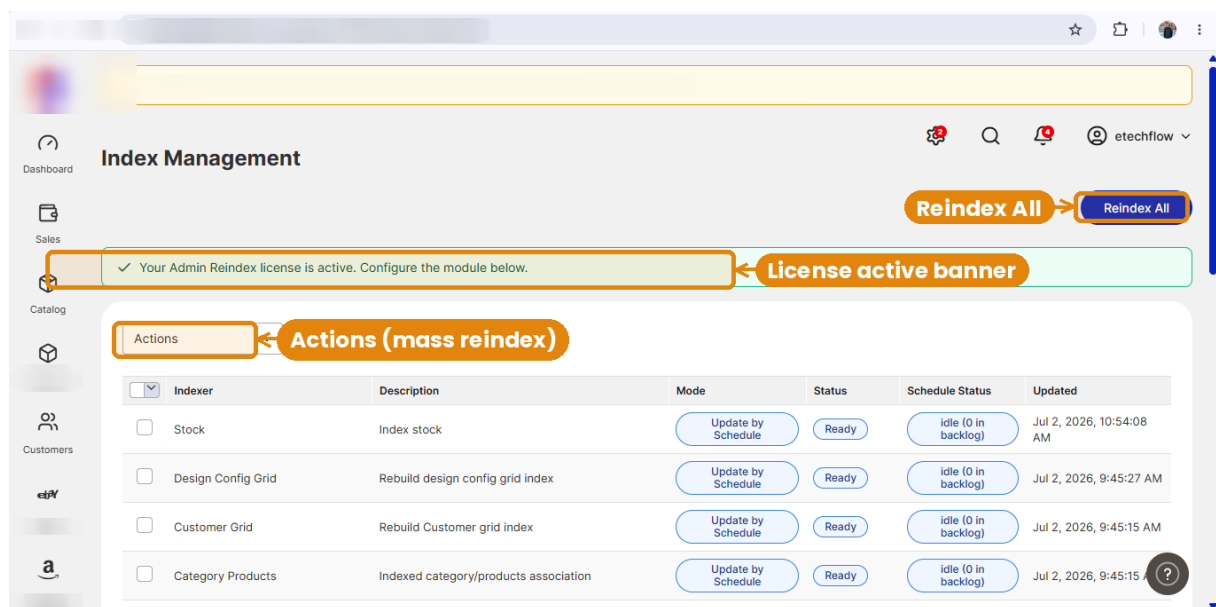


Figure 9 — Index Management with Admin Reindex active: the green “Your Admin Reindex license is active” banner, the Reindex All button (top right), and the Actions mass-action dropdown above the grid.

2.1 Open Index Management

The green banner “Your Admin Reindex license is active. Configure the module below.” confirms the licence is working. The grid lists all Magento indexers (16 here) with their Mode, Status, Schedule Status and last Updated time.

2.2 Reindex All

[Reindex All] The blue button at the top right. Click it to rebuild EVERY indexer in one action, straight from the browser — no SSH or ``bin/magento indexer:reindex`` needed. A progress/confirmation message shows when the job finishes.

2.3 Mass reindex selected indexers

To rebuild only specific indexers, tick their checkboxes on the left of the grid, then use the Actions dropdown.

[**Checkboxes**] Select one or more indexer rows (or use the header checkbox to select all).

[**Actions → Reindex**] The mass-action dropdown above the grid. Choose the Reindex action to rebuild just the selected indexers.

2.4 Reading the grid

[**Indexer**] The indexer name (e.g. Stock, Customer Grid, Category Products, Design Config Grid).

[**Description**] What that indexer builds.

[**Mode**] “Update by Schedule” (cron-driven) or “Update on Save” (immediate). This is Magento's standard indexer mode.

[**Status**] “Ready” (up to date), “Reindex required”, or “Processing”.

[**Schedule Status**] For scheduled indexers, the changelog backlog, e.g. “idle (0 in backlog)”.

[**Updated**] When the indexer was last rebuilt.

That's the whole module: a licensed, one-click way to rebuild any or all Magento indexers from the admin, so store staff can refresh product, price, category and search data without a developer or the command line.
